

SELECTION CRITERIA

WA International School Student of the Year

The **CISWA WA International School Student of the Year Award** is about recognising the significant contribution that international students make to the Western Australian community.

CISWA are looking to acknowledge an international student, who has demonstrated academic excellence and has contributed to enhancing the student experience both on and off campus.

In selecting the recipient of this award, the student's achievements and contributions during their time as an international student in Australia will be taken into consideration. Additional weight will be given to any activities which promote interaction with domestic students and with the local community.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The student's contributions and achievements
- Benefits to the broader student community and/or the broader community of the student's activities
- All community and volunteer work undertaken
- Previous awards and recognition
- Formal or informal awards or achievements as an individual, or as part of a team project, group or organization
- Demonstrated academic excellence (minimum Credit average)
- The student must currently hold a Student Visa within the Schools sector.

REFEREE QUESTIONS

- Outline your relationship with the candidate?
- What was the experience like working with the student?
- Can you describe the candidate's school performance? Did they maintain and demonstrate positive working relationships with other students?
- What are the candidate's strengths and weaknesses?
- Why do you think they should win the award?
