

SELECTION CRITERIA

WA International Education Program of the Year Award

This award recognises the work of an individual or team in a Western Australian education institution that has contributed to the welfare or support of international students. For example, communication support programs, pathways initiative, or social inclusion activities.

Additional weight will be given to any activities which promote interaction with domestic students, with the local community or help students settle into life in Australia.

Eligibility:

- An individual or a team working in an institution that is a current financial CISWA member.
- Institutions must be a registered CRICOS provider.
- Unsuccessful nominees may be re-nominated in subsequent years.

Selection Criteria

- Is it innovative?
- Does it benefit international students and/or integrate international students with local students and/or benefit the local community
- What reach in terms of number of students (of the cohort)
- Is it replicable?
- How readily accessible is it to international students? i.e., preferably free of charge, well promoted

How to apply:

In 1000 words or less provide a summary which outlines:

- - the initiative or achievements shown by the individual or team
 - the outcomes for the institutions/sector/field of international education
 - who benefited from the initiative/project
