

SELECTION CRITERIA

WA Outstanding Individual Contribution to International Education Award

The **CISWA WA Outstanding Individual Contribution to International Education Award** recognises an individual who has made a significant contribution to the enhancement of international education in the State. The achievements will have improved the experience of international students and/or the development of the sector in WA.

In choosing the recipient of the award regard is given not only to the nominee's achievements in the year immediately prior to the award but also to their achievements and on-going contribution to the experience of international students in WA and/or to the success of the international education industry.

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The Selection Panel will evaluate some, or all, of the following factors within the context of Western Australia:

- Contribution to the experience of international students through innovative practices and/or on-going support.
- Contribution to the success of the international education industry through leadership and/or the introduction of innovative practices.
- Contribution to international education in WA through training, development and leadership of others involved in supporting international students and/or in growing the industry.
- The extent to which their example has inspired and been followed by others.
